At build out, the Mission Bay development will be home to 6,000 residential units (28% affordable housing), 11,000 new residents, 31,000 permanent jobs created by a new UCSF life science campus, hospital and other biotech/commercial/retail developments. Come learn how the San Francisco Redevelopment Agency (SFRA) converted these historic shipping and rail yard properties into a new vibrant mixed-use neighborhood in less than a decade.

During this two and a half-hour workshop/tour, SFRA staff and industry experts will discuss the long-range development, planning and financial strategies used to create public infrastructure and affordable housing within this redevelopment project area. A one and a half-hour presentation will be followed up by a one-hour bus/walking tour.
