Leadership in Innovation Award

The Leadership in Innovation Award recognizes MMANC members that have demonstrated local leadership in the design or development of a project or program that solves a particular problem and may be duplicated by other members or other agencies. Awards may be given out in one or more of the following categories:

- **Economic Impact** (Fiscal Stability / Resource Efficiency / Revenue Generation)
- **Public Communication and Outreach** (Brochures, Websites, Marketing Campaigns, programs/events involving residents as partners to facilitate community problem solving, etc)
- **Environmental Sustainability** (innovation and implementation of sustainability and energy efficiency programs that reduce greenhouse gas emissions and improve the quality of life of within the communities that they represent)
- **Neighborhood / Community Life** (programs, services, or special events that enhance or improve neighborhood and/or community life)
- **Employee Development and Professional Growth**
